Webinars in short:

Dates and deadlines?

- Application deadline: 15.03.2021 (feedback by SGS/4S board by 01.04.2021)
- Implementation of the webinars: May to December 2021

Who can organize a webinar?

- At least two institutions from Switzerland organize a webinar.
- The organizers must be members of the SGS/4S. The organizers do not have to present themselves.
- It is possible to invite international experts. We propose to include speakers from Switzerland (whenever possible).
- Each webinar must cover a discipline of sports science.

Organization and administration

- The main topic of the webinar should be approached from different perspectives. Since the webinar are open to non-specialists and students, a general introduction to the topic is preferred.
- A webinar should last approx. 2-4 hours and include at least 3 speakers.
- The webinars must take place on weekdays.
- Time: between 9 am and 5 pm.
- An online broadcast of the webinar is obligatory. An on-site broadcast is optional.
- There is the possibility of professional production if all speakers come to Magglingen/Macolin.
- The webinar must be held in English.

Funding and financing

- The SGS/4S Board will evaluate the applications. Six webinars per year will be supported. The SGS/4S provides 500 Swiss francs per webinar.
- The money is to be used to pay the (inter)national speakers.
- The SGS/4S aims to promote as many areas of sports science as possible.
- Participation in the webinars is generally free of charge.
- The SGS/4S will promote the webinars (mail and webpage). We encourage the organizers to use further ways of publicity to reach as many interested people as possible.
